Disabled Access Statement

The main church car park has 3 disabled parking bays with good tarmac path access to the Centre. There are a further 2 bays next to the west entrance of the Centre itself, providing level access into the building.

The Centre is on one level and disabled WCs are available next to the west entrance and in the Garden Room.

Access to the Centre is via graded pathways. However, the incline to the main entrance door on the north side is the steepest entrance. Where necessary, for some wheelchair or elderly users, arrangements can be made with the Centre management for access assistance into the building.

Emergency egress from the building will be through the West, East or North entrances. The West and East emergency exits each have level access immediately outside.

In the event of an emergency, the Evacuation point will be either the Church building itself or the main church car park. This is dependent on the weather.

There will be a hearing loop available in the main hall and automatic lighting via sensors to the toilets and corridors.

All stepped entrances to the building are edged in yellow in order to ensure the facilities are accessible for people who have a visual impairment.
